FEE PAYMENT

- ✓ Fees can be paid as 6 (half yearly) or Annually.
- ✓ Fees need to be paid between 1 to 7 date of the due month.
 - ✓ No reminders will be given.





DISCIPLINE POLICY

- For School Discipline policies, please refer the School Hand Book.
- If a student is found talking or copying during the test or examination, following will be the consequences he/ she will have to face.
 - 1st time <u>Directly zero marks will be given.</u>
 - 2nd time Suspension
 - 3rd time Student will be asked to leave the school.



LEAVE POLICY

- In case of illness, the school should be notified within 2 days and a medical certificate is mandatory.
- Once in school, no leave will be granted for half day without prior permission.
- Attendance record: 85% attendance is required
- Average marks : Due to school representation or medical reason.
- Medically unfit on day of test: informed latest by the morning



LEAVE POLICY

- No Re-Test will be conducted for casual absence on test days.
 - Absent will be marked which will be considered as 'zero'.
- All rights are reserved to the school in case of any change in discipline policy or actions.

Zero Tolerance Discipline Policy

Bus Discipline

- Students can only switch from their assigned bus with a written request from a parent/guardian.



Bus Discipline

- Any complaints should be reported to the teacher or transport office.
- **❖** Parents are not allowed to stop the bus or board the bus to scold the child.
- Strict actions would be taken in case if child or parent is found breaking the decorum of school bus.



VRAJBHOOMI Assessment

As per the guidelines of CBSE we will have four Unit Tests along with Half Yearly and CBSE Board Examination

- Unit Test I 25 Marks
- Unit Test II 35 Marks
- Unit Test III 45 Marks
- Half Yearly Exam 70/80 Marks
- Unit Test IV 25 Marks
- Pre-Board Exam Class XII: 70/ 80 Marks (Full course)

Note: Further changes will be informed as per CBSE norms. Revision would be done before every exam.


