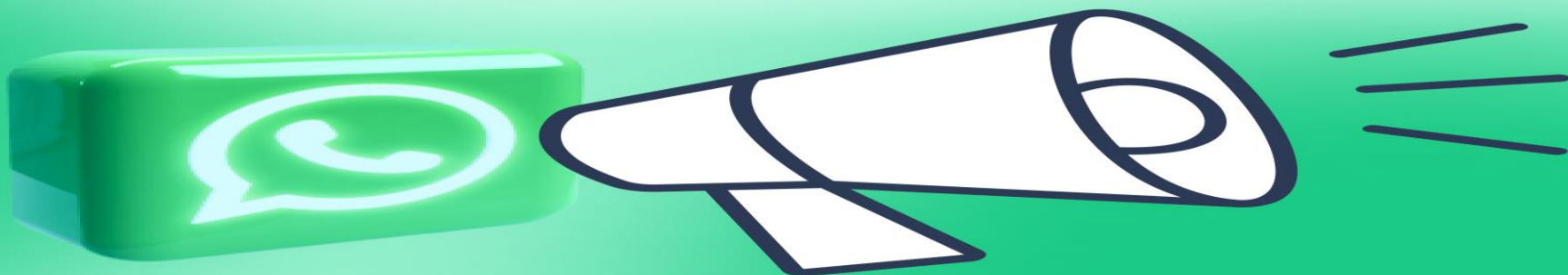
FEES DETAILS

- ❑ Parents are requested not to message or call any teacher personally for any kind of school work.



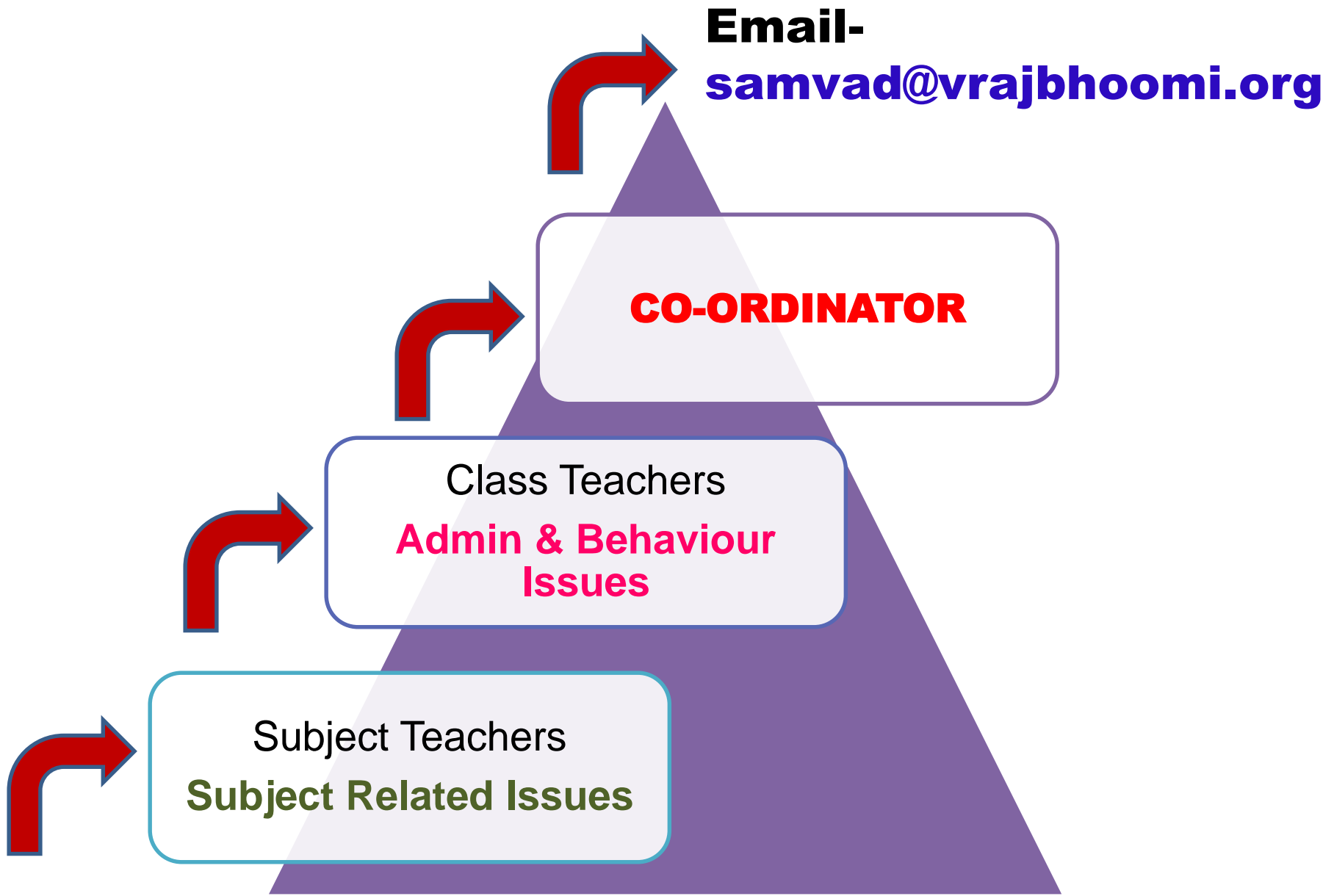

SCHOOL RULES

❖ If your child is interested to select homemade food, submit the application for the same in the beginning of the Term itself.



❖ Once the consent has been given, no student would be allowed to change from school food to homemade food and vice-versa. Same is applicable for Transport

LEAVE POLICY



- ❑ A student, suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should submit a doctor's certificate before resuming the school.
- ❑ Also a student suffering from an infectious or contagious disease will not be permitted to attend the school until it is advisable by the doctor.
- ❑ In case of illness, the school should be notified within 2 days and a medical certificate is mandatory.
- ❑ Once in school, no leave will be granted for half day without prior permission.
- ❑ No Re-Test will be conducted for casual absence on Test Days.
- ❑ Average Marks will be given in case the child is absent due to representing school outside.
- ❑ On the day of test if the child is medically unfit, the same should be informed latest by the morning on the same day.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

- ❖ **Uniform:**

COMPETITIVE EXAMS

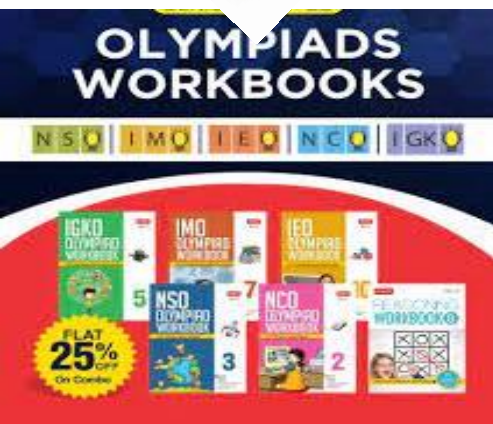
➤ **For Co- curricular and Extra curricular activities refer school calendar.**

➤ **Improve their academic performance and compare their knowledge level and exam readiness.**






Weight of the BAG...

- Weight of the bag is a real concern for the physical well being of a child.
- **Some suggestions :**
- Bag should be light weighted (Don't buy/use heavy bag for school)
- Textbooks without binding or only paper binding
- 100 pages notebook for all subjects except Math notebook
- Carry only those books to school / home which are necessary.
- **Fancy compass, pen pencils, steel scale is not allowed.**
- We expect your cooperation for the correct posture of our children.

Self Study



- **Students need to read chapter for fluency and clarity.**
- **Regular practice of sum and tables are necessary.**
- **Handwriting practice is required.**
- **Parents need to have a daily conversation with students. They need to be aware about students' daily work.**

- **In many cases students are not able to do things and become self dependent so take one step at a time.**
