

### **REMEDIAL SESSION AND HOBBY TIME**




- Remedial session will be there in the morning wherein the subject teachers will decide the students who require remediation.

- Selection for each hobby will be based on the aptitude of the student and final decision will be taken only by the teacher in-charge.


















- A consent form will be sent to the parents before one and a half month, if you will write yes in it and then refuse to send your child for excursion then Transport Amount would be charged.

# **LEAVE POLICY**

 $\succ$ 

- A student, suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should submit a doctor's certificate before resuming the school.
- Also a student suffering from an infectious or contagious disease will not be permitted to attend the school until it is advisable by the doctor.
- In case of illness, the school should be notified within 2 days and a medical certificate is mandatory.
   However, it must be informed on/before the same day of the exam. Otherwise, student will be considered as absent for the exam.
