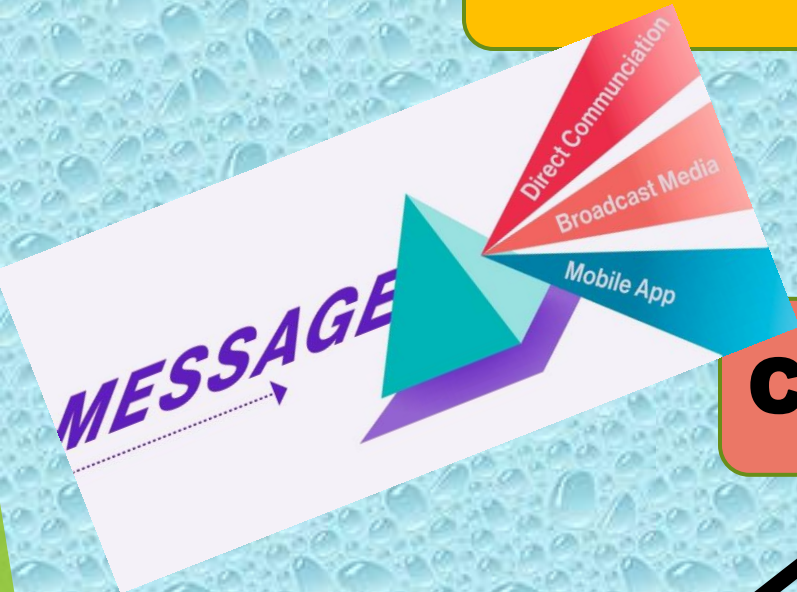
CLASS WISE BROADCAST GROUP

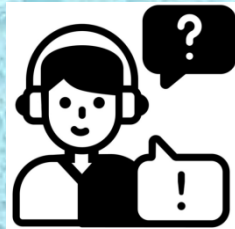

The syllabus will be bifurcated into physics, chemistry and biology

Mostly dictation or marking in textbook for answers

Be attentive, learn spellings and increase the writing speed

Precise diagrams

Regular practise and work on drawing skills

Increase in the length of answers as students will be expected to write in detail/description

Do more practice of writing different patterns and answers in length. Make your own notes/mind maps.

Ratio of objective and subjective questions will vary

Read the chapters thoroughly. Form writing practise for preparation during tests

Uniform

- ✓ Parents must ensure that their child comes to school in proper uniform.
- ✓ **If not in proper uniform**, the child should have a valid reason in the form of a note duly signed by the parent / guardian only or else the child will be **asked to sit on the floor of the class for that particular day.**

HAIR DO [FOR BOYS & GIRLS]

BOYS:

- A well trimmed simple haircut.
- No fancy haircut will be permitted



GIRLS:

- Hair below shoulder, tied in one plait.
- Hair above shoulder-black hair bands or pony tail.





No Nail art in school



No Jewellery (including religious stones)

Only basic religious material would be allowed to be worn





Irregular H.W. / C.W

- ✓ **The student will have to face consequences.**
- ✓ **If found irregular consistently, privileges will be taken away.**

HOME FOOD FACILITY

- ✓ Healthy food menu has already been sent to the parents - The menu should be followed precisely.
- ✓ **No onion, garlic**
- ✓ Napkin is compulsory.
- ✓ Sharing Home Food with Regular Students and / Not Sitting in the Assigned Class.
- ✓ **Food will be taken & privileges will be taken away after one or two warnings.**





Exam Policy



- ✓ For School Rules please refer the School Hand Book.
- ✓ If a student is found talking or copying during the test or examination, following will be the consequences he/ she will have to face.
 - ✓ 1st time – Directly “0” mark will be given.
 - ✓ 2nd time – Suspension
 - ✓ 3rd time – Student will be asked to leave the school.





LEAVE POLICY



- A student, suffering from an **infectious or contagious disease** should submit a doctor's certificate before resuming the school.
- Also a student suffering from **an infectious or contagious disease** will not be permitted to attend the school until it is advisable by the doctor.
- **In case of illness, the school should be notified within 2 days and a medical certificate is mandatory. However, it must be informed on/before the same day of the exam. Otherwise, student will be considered as absent for the exam.**



LEAVE POLICY (CONTL.)

- Once in school, **no leave will be granted for half day** without prior permission.
- **No Re-Test will be conducted for casual absence on test days.**
- **Average marks will be given in case the child is representing the school outside.**

Bus Discipline

- ✓ Student should board the bus on time.
- ✓ **Students should conduct themselves in an acceptable manner at all times.**
- ✓ Abusive language, obscene gestures, horseplay, throwing objects, fighting and other improper conduct will not be tolerated.



Bus Discipline

- ✓ Eatables are strictly prohibited on school buses.
- ✓ Students can only switch from their assigned bus with a written request from a parent/guardian.
- ✓ Any complaints should be reported to the transport office or teacher.



Bus Discipline

- ✓ Parents are not allowed to stop the bus or board the bus to scold the child.
- ✓ **Strict actions** would be taken in case if **child or parent is found breaking the decorum of school bus.**

 - **Is the water bottle too heavy?**

- **Check and sign(if required) the handbook daily.**
- **Encourage your child to be responsible towards his/her own work and follow the manners.**



OUR EXPECTATIONS FROM PARENTS

- **Keep a track of classwork and its completion.**
- **A child should ask doubts if he/she doesn't understand something.**
- **Attend every PTM as per the time slot given and also make sure to meet respective subject teachers to know your child's performance.**
- **Encourage and help your child to do self studies rather than sending them to tuition.**
- **Plan a schedule together and ensure it is followed.**



OUR EXPECTATIONS FROM PARENTS



- **The school is not in the favour of tuition, however, if the parents require to send the child for the same, make sure that the tutor attends the PTM, to ensure the use of common methodology of teaching.**
- **Attendance record will be checked before Mid-Term and Annual exam. If it is found less than 85% then the grade of the student will go down.**
- **Vision of school and parents should be the same.**
- **Follow the instructions given for educational excursion – no eatables, chewing gums, gadgets and money.**
