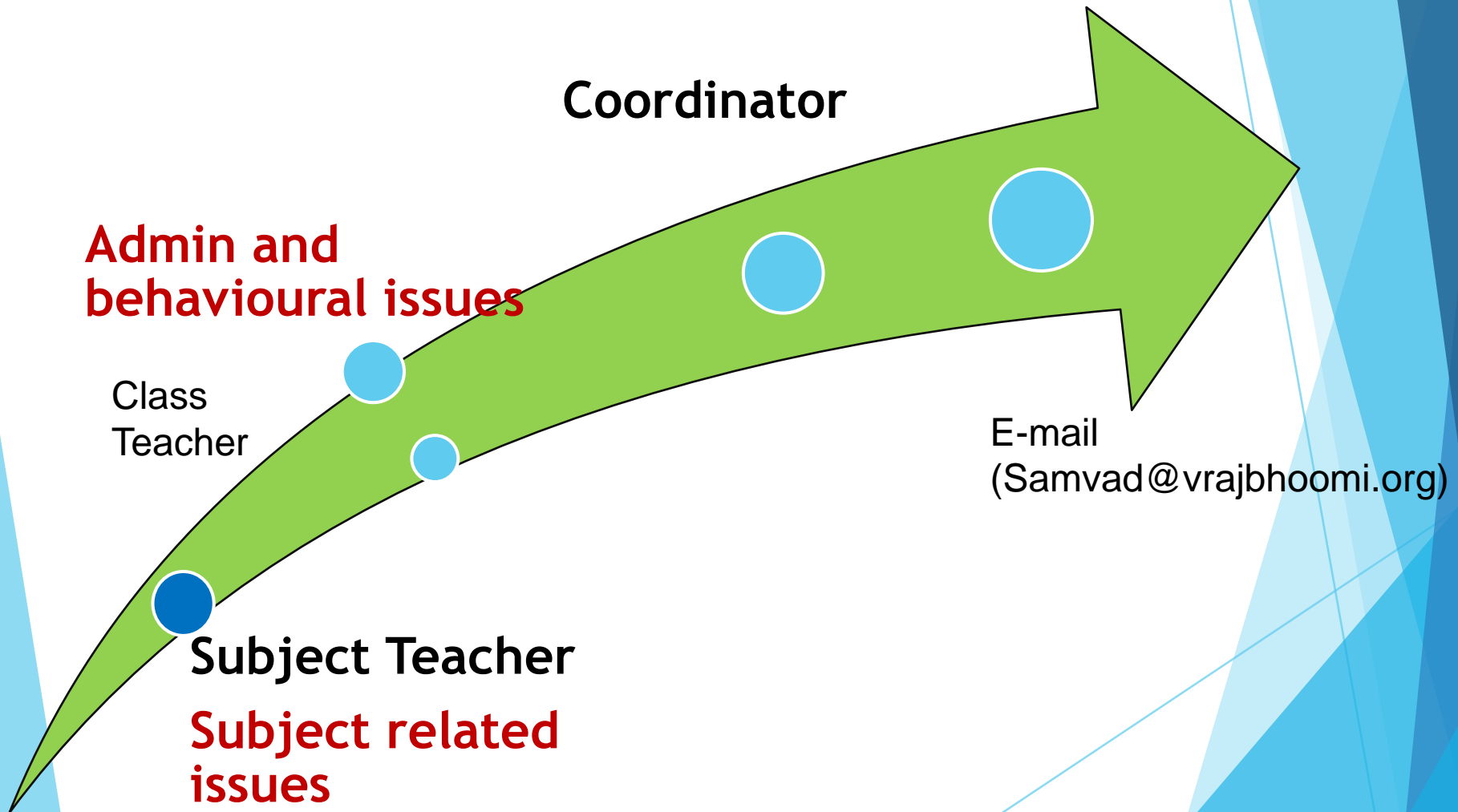

## BOYS:

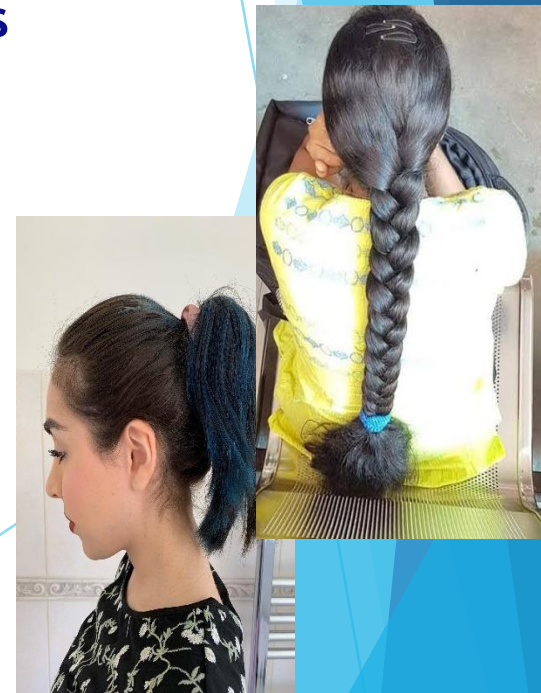
- ❖ A well trimmed simple haircut.

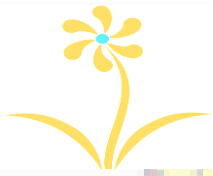




## Sharing Home Food with Regular Students and / Not Sitting in the Assigned Class

- ❖ No junk food, no onion garlic.
- ❖ Menu is shared need to be followed.
- ❖ Compulsory to follow the menu given day wise or else the lunch box will be taken away.
- ❖ Compulsory to carry a Napkin.(school/home food)
- ❖ Privileges will be taken away after one or two warnings.
- ❖ Even if child is asking other child to bring food then both will have to face the consequences.
- ❖ Once you opt for any (home food / school food), no changes can be made.





# Bus Discipline

- ❖ Student should board the bus on time.
- ❖ Students should conduct themselves in an acceptable manner at all times.
- ❖ Abusive language, obscene gestures, horseplay, throwing objects, fighting and other improper conduct will not be tolerated.
- ❖ Eatables are strictly prohibited on school buses.
- ❖ Students can only switch from their assigned bus with a written request from a parent/guardian.



# Bus Discipline

# Assessment

- As per the guidelines of CBSE we will have two periodic tests i.e. Periodic I and II along with Term and Annual Exams.
- **Periodic I - 30 Marks**
- **Term Exam - 50 Marks (Course of PT-I included)**
- **Periodic II - 70 Marks (will include course of PT-I & Term Exam)**
- **Annual Exam - Class IX: 80 Marks (Full course)**
- **Pre-Board Exam - Class X: 80 Marks (Full course)**

**Note: Further changes will be informed as per CBSE norms.**



# Assessment

- **Periodic Test** will be conducted in the form of **Cyclic Test**.
- For **schedule** of cyclic Periodic test, please **go through** the **WEBSITE**.

Class 9<sup>th</sup> passing criteria will be same as Class 10<sup>th</sup> Board Exam decided by CBSE.

Example :

One child scores: 18.5/80 and 15.3/20

So total is : 33.8/100

Whereas other child scores 19.5/80 & 12.1/20

So total is : 31.6/100

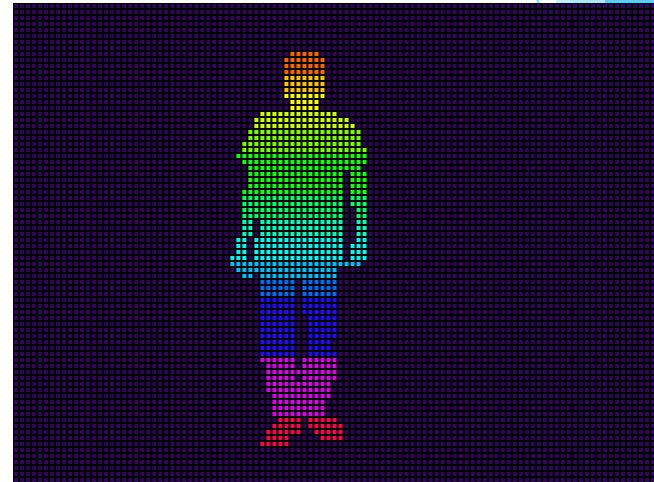

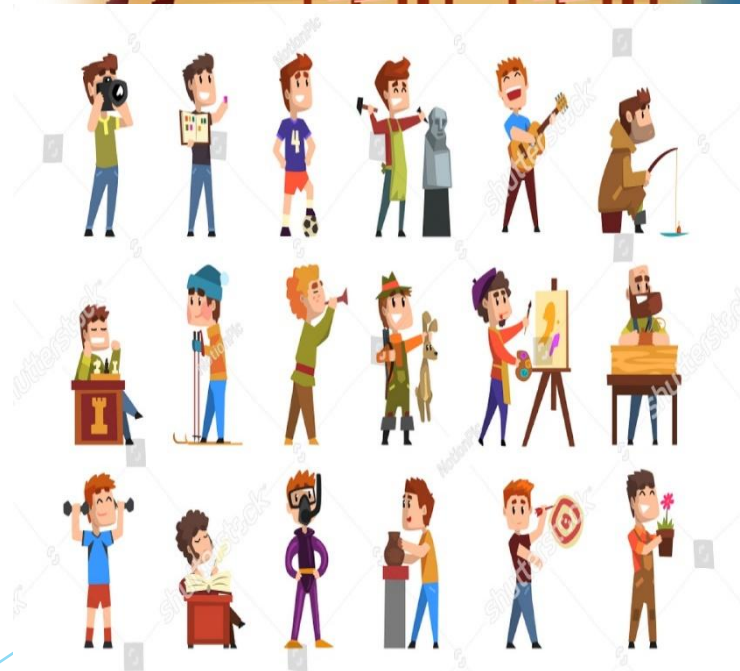

# IMPORTANT NEWS FOR CLASS X

- According to CBSE Circular No. Acad-03/19, there are two levels of Mathematics examination from the academic session 2019-2020.
  - 1) Basic (Easier Level)
  - 2) Standard (Existing Level)
- The Standard level will be meant for students who wish to opt for Mathematics at Senior Secondary level and Basic level will be for other students.

• **Separate paper only in Board Exam .**

• **Not applicable in internal assessment.**

• **Chapters and methodology will be same.**

• In case student fails at any level of Mathematics, he/she can appear at the compartment examination as per norms of the Board according to the options given below:

• **If the student qualifies the Basic level , shall given an option to appear in Mathematics-Standard at the time of compartment exam, in case he/she changes his/her mind pursue Mathematics at Sr. Secondary Level.**

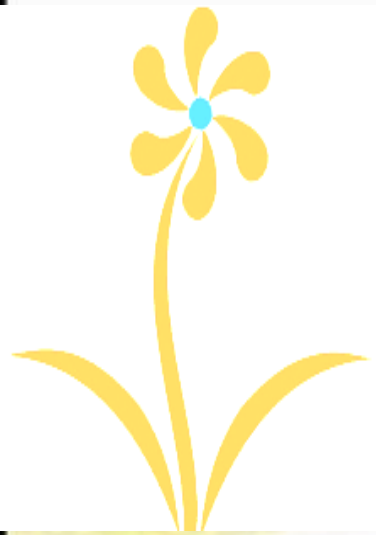




# IMPORTANT NEWS FOR CLASS X

## Additional 6<sup>th</sup> Subject

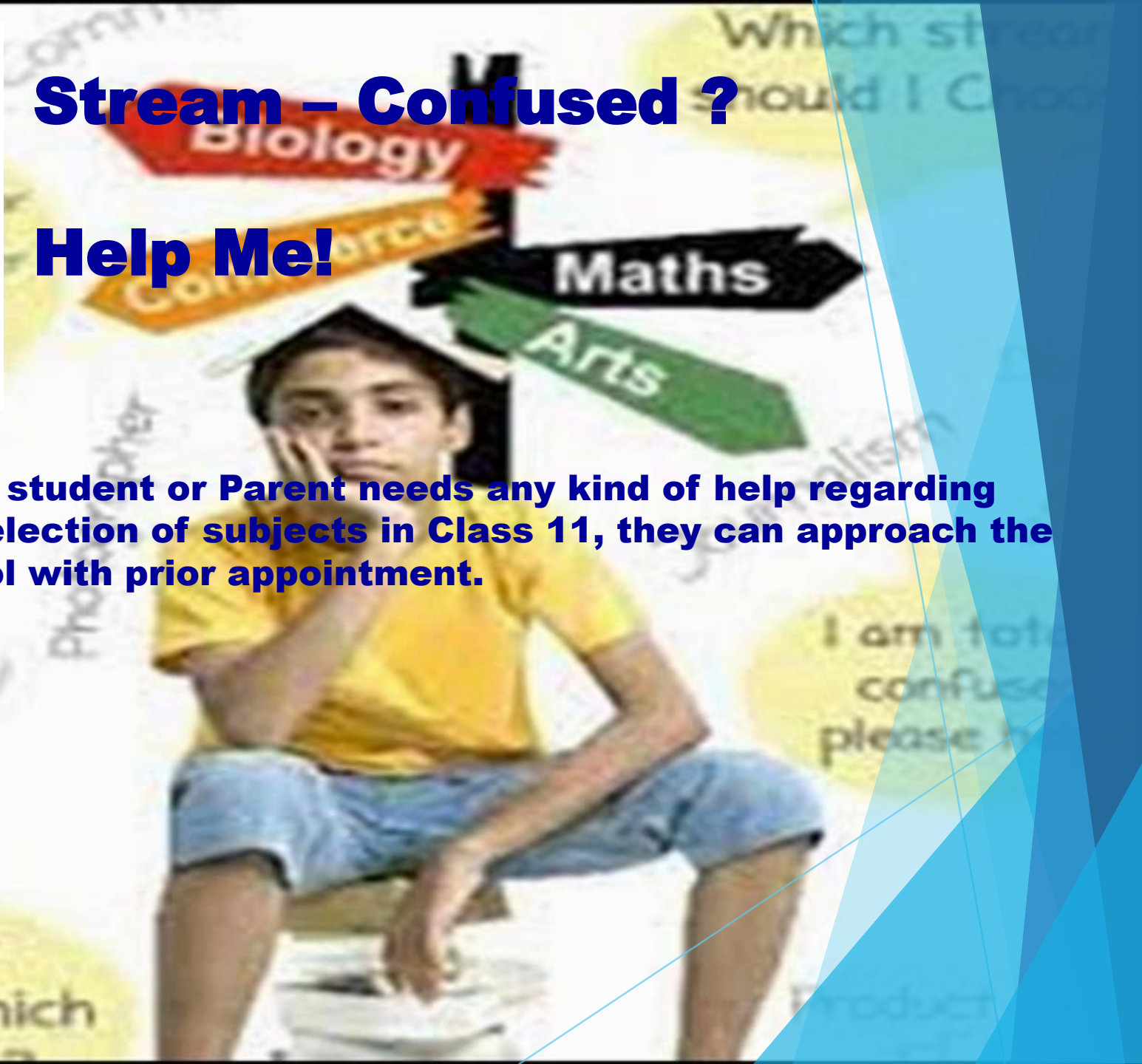
- **Computer Science will be the 6<sup>th</sup> subject to be assessed for class X. It is voluntary for a student to have it.**
- **If any student fails in any one of the three elective subjects (i.e, Science, Mathematics and Social Science), then it will be replaced by the Vocational subject (offered as a 6th additional subject) and result of Class X Board Examination will be computed accordingly.**
- **However, if a candidate desires to reappear in the failed subject, he/she may appear along with the compartment examination.**
