# Leave Policy



- A student, suffering from an **infectious** or **contagious disease** will not be permitted to attend the school until it is advisable by the doctor.
- In case of **illness**, the school should be notified within **2 days** and a medical certificate is mandatory.
- Also a student suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should **submit a doctor's certificate** before resuming the school.

➤ **Once in school, no leave will be granted for half day.**

➤ **In case of absence for more than 3 days, a leave note duly signed by the parent to be submitted to the class teacher.**





- **No Re-Test** will be conducted for **casual absence on test days**. Absent will be **marked** which will be considered as **‘zero’**.
- Average marks will be given in case the child is absent due to school representation or medical reason.
- On the day of test if the child is **medically unfit**, the same should be informed latest by the morning on the same day.



# EXAM POLICY

- ✓ **For School Rules please refer the School Hand Book.**
- ✓ **85% attendance is required , if not then the child will not be allowed to sit for the mid-term or term exam.**
- ✓ **If a student is found talking or copying during the test or examination, following will be the consequences he/ she will have to face.**
  - ✓ **1<sup>st</sup> time – Directly “0” mark will be given.**
  - ✓ **2<sup>nd</sup> time – Suspension**
  - ✓ **3<sup>rd</sup> time – Student will be asked to leave the school.**

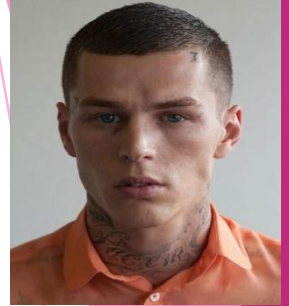




# HAIR DO [FOR BOYS & GIRLS]

# Sharing Home Food with Regular Students and / Not Sitting in the Assigned Class

# Uniform



- ✓ Parents must ensure that their child comes to school in proper uniform.
- ✓ If **not in proper uniform**, the child should have a valid reason in the form of a note duly signed by the parent / guardian only or else the child will be **asked to sit on the floor of the class for that particular day.**



# Bus Discipline

- ✓ Student should board the bus on time.

- ✓ Eatables are strictly prohibited on school buses.

# PROMOTION CRITERIA FOR GRADE 8 – GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES

**According to these guidelines, a student will be eligible for promotion to the next class only if he/she secures a minimum of 33% marks in each individual subject overall.**

Class 8<sup>th</sup> passing criteria will be same as Class 10<sup>th</sup> Board Exam decided by CBSE.

One child scores: 18.5/80[pen paper] and 15.3/20[internal]

So total is : 33.8/100

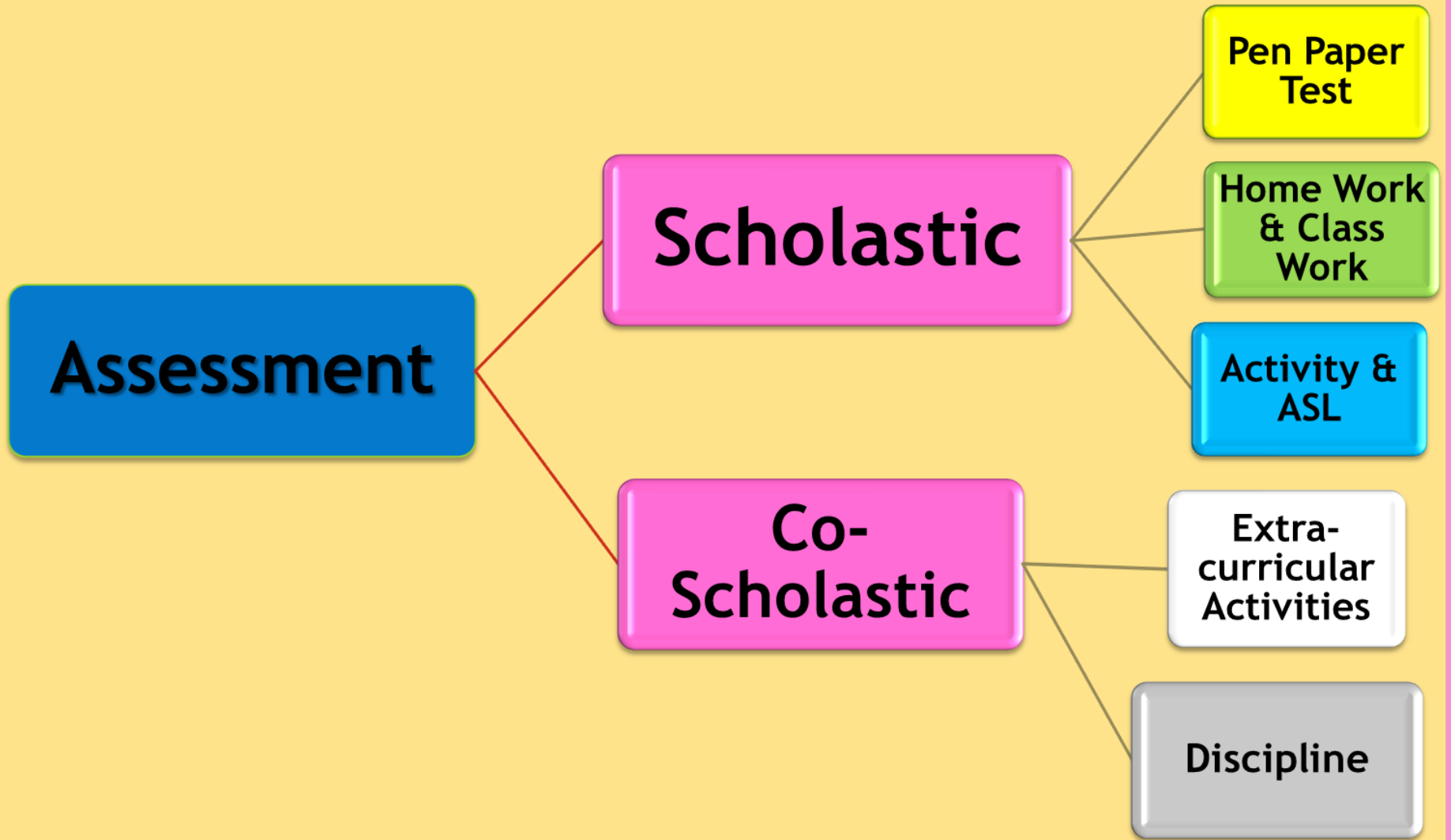
